The Swannanoa Valley Ministerial Association is sponsoring Community Worship Services for the Wednesdays of Lent and on Good Friday. Each service begins at noon and lasts for about 30 minutes. A light lunch follows each service (with the exception of Ash Wednesday and Good Friday). An offering will be taken at each service for the Swannanoa Valley Christian Ministries' "healing fund." All are invited to these services which help us to prepare ourselves for our holiest day of Easter. The schedule is as follows:

## Montreat Wednesday March 4: NOAA



National Oceanic and  
Atmospheric Administration  
U.S. Department of Commerce

This Wednesday, March 4, **Deke Arndt**, representing the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, a U.S. government scientific agency, will bring us a crucial presentation, ***Pulse of the Planet: How we track and understand global, national and regional climate conditions at Asheville's National Centers for Environmental Information.***

This presentation will cover climate monitoring activities at Asheville's National Centers for Environmental Information in Asheville, the world's largest repository of weather and climate information. We will touch on the

state of the global climate system, and what and how we measure, but will focus on observed and expected changes in our region, including how climate change is or isn't related to changes in certain types of extreme weather. We will end with a story.

Deke is the Chief of the Climate Monitoring team at NOAA's National Centers for Environmental Information in Asheville. They are responsible for measuring changes and variations in Earth's climate, from long-term global temperature to localized drought emergencies. He is one of the two lead editors of the State of the Climate Report, published annually in the Bulletin of the American Meteorological Society (AMS). He just began a three year stint as a Councilor for the the AMS. He holds a B.S. and M.S. in Meteorology from the University of Oklahoma.

**Upcoming Worship Services  
for the Seasons of Lent and Easter**



**The liturgical season leading up to Easter is called Lent.** Lent is a time of grateful humility, an opportunity for Christians to prepare for Easter by engaging in deep personal reflection on their own faithfulness in light of the cross and what God has done for us, and is doing for us, in Christ. **Lent can be a challenging spiritual discipline** for those who choose to enter into it. The church's role is both to help disciples explore the challenge unflinchingly and to provide comfort and encouragement for those on the journey.

**Lent begins with Ash Wednesday and lasts 40 days** (not counting

Sundays), culminating in Holy Week, which includes Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. On behalf of Montreat Presbyterian Church and in the name of Christ, I invite you to come confidently with us on a life changing journey!

The Swannanoa Valley Ministerial Association is again hosting **Wednesday noon services and lunches** throughout Lent. Our Sunday for hosting will be March 25.

**The Easter season**, which begins with the First Sunday of Easter, usually called Easter Sunday, is the Church's commemoration and celebration ("feast") of the resurrection of Jesus. This year, Easter Sunday falls on April 12.
